Employees in the district administrative offices or their relatives (mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, husband, wife, aunt, uncle, son-in-law, or daughter-in-law). Members of the Board of Education or their spouses."

- Votes will be tallied at the close of the election. The top 2 vote recipients will be the Knox Central S.B.D.M. parent representatives for the remainder of the 2017 – 2018 academic year.
- The newly elected parent representatives, along with the teachers and principal will attend a 6 hour S.B.D.M. training provided by K.D.E.
