## Information\* for the Knox County Art Show 2018 \*Please note there are a few changes...

- 1. Each entry must have the following information attached to the **FRONT RIGHT HAND CORNER** on a 2"X2" paper (form attached): Artist, Grade, Teacher and School for students preschool thru eighth. Ninth thru twelfth grades will include a category listing. Please use the attached form.
- 2. All entries must have a **STATEMENT OF AUTHENTICITY** on the back of the entry. Please use the attached form. **All work must be independently student done!**
- 3. The artist must remember **you may NOT use** any copyrighted materials such as cartoon characters, logos, etc.
- 4. Entries should be no larger that 18" X 24" including matting or mounting. NO entries will be accepted in a frame.
- 5. No entry will be accepted if it is not properly matted/mounted and unless it has all the necessary information.
  - \*\* Matting may be done by first attaching the pictures to a sturdy poster board (no construction paper) and laying a cut out poster board frame over the picture and securing it. **OR**
  - \*\* Mounting may be done by gluing the picture on a piece of sturdy poster board.
- 6. All pictures will be attached to our display boards. **DO NOT** submit pictures that are too thick/heavy to be attached, they will not be accepted. Exceptions are if art is done on canvas.
- 7. **Elementary (PS-6) schools:** Each school may submit **three (3)** entries **per grade level. Middle schools (7-8)** may submit **five (5) entries per grade level.**
- 8. **High schools:** Students may enter **one** (1) entry in each category, a maximum of 4 per
  - student: 1. Drawing Pencil, ink or charcoal
    - 2. Painting Oil, Watercolors or Acrylic
    - 3. Mixed media Combination of drawing and painting
    - 4. Photography Must be taken by student

(Photography entries will **NOT** be considered for Best of Show since this is an art show.)

- 9. Representatives should compile a list of school entries to turn in with their school's art.
- 10. Your school's representative/contact is \* Please See Below . School representatives are responsible for bringing the art for his/her school to the First United Methodist Church.
- 11. Judges decisions are final and cannot be contested. Awards will be given for the following:
  - 1. Best of Show
  - 2. 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each grade level/category
  - 3. Honorable mention where applicable
  - 4. Ribbons and certificates for all participants

- 12. Entries should be taken by your school's contact person to the **First United Methodist Church** on North Main Street in Barbourville (across from Knox County Middle) on

  <u>Wednesday, March 14</u>, from <u>3:30-4:15 pm only!</u>
- 14. Entries will be on display at the First United Methodist Church during the following: Monday, March 19, 12-7 pm.
- 15. The presentation of awards will be held at the First United Methodist Church on Monday, March 19, at 7:00 pm. A reception will be held after the presentation of awards.
- 16. The Knox County Art Show Committee will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any entry. All entries must be submitted in accordance with specifications listed in this information sheet.
- 17. Students will not be permitted to take their entries after the reception on that evening. They will be asked to wait and pick up their entries from their respective schools. A Knox County Art Show Committee member will try to return entries to the schools by the next Wednesday, March 21. Questions, please call Rita Wood at 545-8247.
